Thank you for your request dated 28 August 2017 under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA) for:

- The number of mobile telephones found in Scottish Prisons for the 2016-2017 year (or the 2016 calendar year, whichever form the information is in) broken down by individual prison.
- The number of mobile telephones found in Scottish Prisons for the previous year (either 2015-16 or the 2015 year) broken down by prison.
- The number of drugs finds in Scottish Prisons for the 2016-17 (or 2016) year, broken down by drug type and prison.
- The number of drugs finds in Scottish Prisons for the previous year (2015-16 or 2015) broken down by drug type and prison.

If you are unhappy with this response to your request, you may ask us to carry out an internal review, by writing to The Chief Executive, Calton House, 5 Redheughs Rigg, Edinburgh, EH12 9HW. Your request should explain why you wish a review to be carried out, and should be made within 40 working days of receipt of this letter, and we will reply within 20 working days of receipt. If you are not satisfied with the result of the review, you then have the right to make a formal complaint to the Scottish Information Commissioner.
