FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST – HQ14303

Thank you for your request which we received on 10 March 2015 under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA) for the following information:

Can you confirm if the ICC can overturn a decision of an RMT, PCMB, RULE 95 grant or a decision of an adverse circumstances Board. Is this within their powers to do so?

We have now completed our search for the information you requested and advise the following in response:

As advised in our letter of 9 March 2015 (response to your FOI request HQ14266), the internal complaints process is designed to consider all complaints raised by prisoners; this will include complaints concerning decisions of a Risk Management Team, Programme Case Management Board, Rule 95 grant or a decision of a Risk Management Team following an adverse development. The Internal Complaints Committee can on completion of their investigations, make a recommendation to the Governor. It is then for the Governor to decide whether to endorse or reject that recommendation.

If you are unhappy with this response to your request, you may ask us to carry out an internal review, by writing to The Chief Executive, Calton House, 5 Redheughs Rigg, Edinburgh, EH12 9HW. Your request should explain why you wish a review to be carried out, and should be made within 40 working days of receipt of this letter, and we will reply within 20 working days of receipt. If you are not satisfied with the result of the review, you then have the right to make a formal complaint to the Scottish Information Commissioner.
