Thank you for your request dated 28 April 2015 under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA). For reference, your request is detailed below.

- 1. The number of mobile phone watch devices found in Scottish prisons, since 2010;*
- 2. Some representative ideas of what models of phone watches were found;*
- 3. Whether any Apple Watch mobile devices have been found in any Scottish prisons, and if so when and which prisons; and*
- 4. Any new measures being taken by the prison service to combat mobile watch device contraband.*

We have now completed our search for the information you requested and our response is detailed below.

- 1. Please find attached a spread sheet for each year from April 2010 – March 2015 showing the number of watch phones found in our prisons.*
- 2. The SPS do not record the make of phones recovered.*
- 3. The SPS do not record the make of phones recovered.*
- 4. All establishments have hand held mobile phone detectors. In addition, the SPS is testing mobile phone blocking equipment as well as walk-through detectors in some of our prisons.*

Your request should explain why you wish a review to be carried out, and should be made within 40 working days of receipt of this letter, and we will reply within 20 working days of receipt. If you are not satisfied with the result of the review, you then have the right to make a formal complaint to the Scottish Information Commissioner.
